



GCSE and BTEC Results 2017

Thursday 24th August 2017

You will need to collect your results from either the Excel Academy from 10am or from the Discovery Academy from 10am to 11.30am

Stay calm on GCSE results day 2017

On results day you will receive a Candidate Statement of your Provisional Results. This statement will detail all your results from examinations taken and controlled assessments completed.

Make sure you pack your mobile phone so you can give your parents/carer a call after getting your results. Pack a bottle of water and some tissues.

Decide where you want to open your GCSE results

It's best to be at the academy to open your results, so you can get advice from your teachers, if you need it - but you can take your results home to open them if you prefer.

Make sure you are not peer-pressured into opening your results in front of your friends, especially if you are not feeling comfortable or confident.

What to do if you are unable to collect your results

If you are unable to collect your results, they can be posted to you if you send in a stamped self-addressed envelope. Or, if you would prefer someone else to

collect your results for you, you will need to send in a letter stating who will be collecting them and that person will need to bring ID when they collect your results.
